If they aren't, they're not compliant with Australian standards.  
The WaterMark means that products are safe, certified, and fit for purpose.

Buying non-compliant products will likely cost you time and money.  
WaterMark certification is mandatory, and if purchased plumbing products  
or fittings don't carry the mark, a licensed plumber will not install it.
