

### Q: I cannot attend the seminar that is scheduled in my capital city?

A: On 16 August, we will also be hosting, for the first time, a live webinar session of the seminar content online. The webinar will follow the same agenda as the face-to-face session, and include the ability for attendees to ask questions about the NCC 2022 changes.

#### Q: How much does it cost?

A:

*If before 1 June 2022:* We are offering an early bird discounted rate for face-to-face seminars, which allows you to **s**ecure your place for \$130 (GST Inc.) per registration. This offer ends 1 June 2022 after which seminar fees will be \$160 (GST Inc.) per registration, or \$130 (GST Inc.) for webinar registrations.

*If after 1 June 2022:* Face-to-face seminar fees are \$160 (GST Inc.) per registration, or it is \$130 (GST Inc.) for webinar registrations.

#### Q: Will energy efficiency and/or condensation mitigation be discussed?

A: Amendments related to NCC 2022 energy efficiency and condensation mitigation will not be presented at this seminar. More information will be available about these changes closer to the commencement of the seminars.

## Q: How long do the seminars go for?

A: The seminars will be half day sessions that will run for four hours from 9.00am to 1.00pm in all locations and include tea/coffee on arrival, and a tea break. The webinar session which will commence at 12.30pm – 4.30pm (AEST) to allow all states and territories to participate.
